House ‘N Home Thermal Efficiency Rebate Program

As of January 1, 2010, the TMLP is pleased to offer financial assistance to our residential and nonprofit customers with the “House N Home” Thermal Efficiency Rebate Program. Eligible customers can be reimbursed up to \$500 per household!

To learn what measures make sense for your home and to get your rebate take advantage of our Home Energy Audit by calling 1-888-772-4242 to schedule your *free of charge* energy audit. You’ll receive information that can start saving you energy and money right away. AND, if you partake of selected measures (listed below) recommended in the audit, we’ll pay for half of it – up to a maximum of \$500!

Who can apply for a rebate?

- Must be a residential customer with active service or Nonprofit Agency that owns the facility
- Must have received an energy Audit through our residential conservation service.
- Must be a residential customer for 6 months or more with no overdue arrears

Are there any priorities or restrictions?

- Electric Heat customers receive priority from January through June. All other customers are eligible on a first come first served basis from July through December, so long as funding lasts.
- Only one rebate per calendar year per customer.

What measures are eligible?

- Attic Insulation
- Wall Insulation
- Rim Joist Insulation
- Window treatments.
- Pipe and Duct Insulation
- Hot water tank wrap

(Replacement doors not eligible under this program. Windows must be Energy Star Rated)

Who does the work?

Work can be done by the homeowner, a contractor, or combination of the two. Where applicable, the contractor must be licensed for the work performed.

How much is the rebate?

The rebate is 50% of the total cost of the job, up to \$ 500 max which includes materials and professional labor. The rebate will be processed as a credit on your bill. Please allow 4-6 weeks for processing.

How can I apply for a rebate?

You must fill out an application for the House ‘N Home Thermal Efficiency Rebate Program, available at our Customer Care Center at 33 Weir Street or online at www.tmlp.com.

Each application must be accompanied by the original sales receipt for any materials purchased and/or the final contractor invoice. A receipt from the contractor as proof of payment is also required.

TMLP reserves the right to inspect or otherwise verify installation of any and all energy-saving measures.
