Residential PV Rebate Program

As of January 1, 2010, the TMLP is pleased to offer financial assistance to our residential customers intending to install a photovoltaic (solar) array on their property. Solar projects up to a maximum of 2.5KW will be taken into consideration for a rebate of \$ 2.00 per watt installed, up to a maximum of \$ 5,000. Projects must be approved by TMLP prior to installation. Projects must also be completed by licensed electricians and professional, licensed contractors. See below for further information.

Who can apply for a rebate?

- Must be a TMLP residential customer with active service
- Must be the owner of record of the property where the installation will occur.
- Must be a residential customer for 6 months or more with no overdue arrears

Are there any restrictions?

- Only one rebate per customer.
- Customer must be the future owner of the PV project and consumer of the electricity generated by the PV installation.

Who does the work?

- A licensed, professional contractor and a licensed electrician must perform the work involved.
- Customer and/or contractors are required to obtain all necessary permitting from the authorities having jurisdiction
- Customer will work with the contractor to submit an accurate Solar Rebate Application.

How do I submit an application?

If the application is deemed complete and eligible, the applicant will be sent a TMLP Net Metering and Interconnection Agreement document and Net Metering Application via US mail or email. Customer will be notified if application is incomplete or ineligible.

How much is the rebate?

The rebate calculation is based on the size of the total PV installation per building, regardless of the number of meters used. The rebate is calculated as total installation wattage times \$2.00 per watt, up to \$ 5,000 maximum. For example, a 2.5 KW system equals 2,500 watts times \$2.00 equals a \$ 5,000 rebate. Rebates will be sent as a check. Please allow 4-6 weeks for processing.

Are there any tax burdens when receiving a rebate?

Rebates may be subject to Federal and/or state income tax reporting. The applicant is responsible for contacting a qualified tax advisor to determine tax liability. TMLP is not responsible for any tax consequences of the solar rebate program.

How can I apply for a rebate?

You must fill out a solar Rebate Application to obtain project approval. All Project Completion paperwork, including contractor sign off and all invoices, must be submitted and approved by TMLP for rebate processing.
