TMLP gets ready to launch its new online look

(Taunton, MA) –Taunton Municipal Lighting Plant (TMLP) will launch newly designed and more customer-friendly websites for its electric and Internet divisions on October 10th.

TMLP customers will be able to pay their bills on line, set up automatic payments, obtain other services and information, and be able to easily access the website when using their home computer or mobile devices.

"TMLP is unique because as one company, we provide both electric service as well as Internet service to our customers," TMLP General Manager Mike Horrigan said.

"And as one company, we recognize that customers may need to access general information as well as specific information about either division from time to time."

Although the unified TMLP website can be accessed by either web address, www.tmlp.com and www.tmlp.net, TMLP customers can seamlessly transition between

the electric and Internet pages by a simple click of the mouse or keyboard, or a touch of the screen on their mobile devices without having to log-on to the other address.

"We're excited to be launching the redesigned sites during Public Power Week, which is observed nationally from October 7th through 13th," General Manager Horrigan added. "This is a great opportunity for TMLP residential, commercial and industrial customers to become familiar with us as a unique public power utility, and when visiting the websites, they'll be able to get energy information, see what we're up to and who we are, and take a look at some of the programs and services we offer like the appliance rebate program and our kids' pages."
