Follow these easy steps to participate in the TMLP Saves<sup>TM</sup> Program!

- Schedule your no-cost home energy audit through Energy New England (ENE). Complete the intake form by <u>using this link</u> to schedule.
  - a. Recommended weatherization measures must be installed within 6 months (before or after) of the heat pump installation.
  - b. If barriers are identified at the ENE audit or during the weatherization scoping visit, then they must be addressed before installing weatherization or heat pumps. Contact TMLP before moving forward.
- Contact TMLP Saves team to review the TMLP rebate process. Email <u>Rebates@tmlp.com</u> to schedule a call.
- Find a contractor on the <u>Heat Pump Administrator (HPA) approved contractors list</u> and receive 1-3 quotes on the installation of an <u>eligible Cold Climate Air Source Heat Pump.</u>
- Have your contractor submit the heat pump administrator's (HPA) Pre-Approval Form
  - a. If pursuing a whole-home rebate: this step is REQUIRED. You must receive approval before moving to the next step.
  - b. If pursuing a partial-home rebate: this step is optional and you can proceed to the next step.
- Submit application to TMLP for processing and qualification. Email PDFs to <a href="Rebates@tmlp.com">Rebates@tmlp.com</a>. Send the following documents:
  - a. TMLP Saves<sup>TM</sup> Program Application Form
  - b. Signed heat pump contract

## Heat Pump Rebate and Zero-Interest Loan Program Customer Checklist

- Upon receiving approval from TMLP, bring the following to the financial institution of your choice:
  - TMLP approval letter
  - Signed Contract
  - TMLP Saves Loan Authorization form
  - Valid form of identification
  - o Paystubs that cover 30 days (i.e. two biweekly paystubs)
- After lender's approval and customer receipt of the two-party Loan check, proceed with the installation.\*
  - a. If weatherization was also recommended, weatherization must be completed within six(6) months of heat pump installation.
- Customer signs two-party check at time of installation for contractor
- After installation, contractor submits the heat pump <u>Install Quality Assurance (QA) form</u> in order to confirm and receive the heat pump rebate.
- TMLP processes rebate check and issues within 6-8 weeks. The check will be a check addressed to the customer.
